

Membership Award

• Top Post in each division will receive \$150.00 to be deposited in their General Fund.

First to Finish District Award

First District to attain 101% by 1 February 2026, will receive \$300 issued to the Ouartermaster for the Districts General Fund.

Honor Post 101% Plus 1

- Divisions 8, 9, 10, and 11 achieving 101% plus 1, and over 50 members by 12/31/2025.
- Division 4, 5, 6 and 7 achieving 101% plus 1 by 1/31/2026.
- Division 1, 2 and 3 achieving 101% plus 1 by 2/28/2026.

Honor Post Award

- Each Honor Post will receive a pennant / plaque designating it as such.
- Each Honor Post will receive \$100 VFW Store Gift Card

ALL STATE CRITERIA

The All-State Program exists to recognize exceptional leadership, above average accomplishments in membership growth and community service as well as support of and participation in the VFW core programs, all while maintaining a positive image to be the standard example presented to our members, sponsors, legislative representatives, and neighboring communities. Keeping these standards high will help to ensure the proliferation of our great organization.

All State Post Criteria

- Achieve membership not less than 101%
- Voice of Democracy Provide a minimum of one entry advanced to the District.
- Patriots Pen Provide a minimum of one entry advanced to District.
- Teacher of the Year Provide a minimum of one entry, in any category (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) advanced to District.

- Police, Fire, Dispatcher, or EMS of the year advanced to District or payment of \$100 to Department.
- Post Commander or their representative (Senior or Junior Vice Commander must attend all District Meetings).
- All Bond Applications, trustee reports, and 990 IRS filings must be submitted prior to established deadlines.
- Participation (team, sponsorship, donations, volunteer support) in the annual Billy Ray Campbell / Otis Brown Scholarship Golf Tournament.
- Sell all allotted Department Raffle Tickets and provide all required documentation as prescribed by the program rules.
- Make a minimum of one \$25 donation to the National Home for Commander in Chief's special project.
- Make a minimum of one \$25 to the Department for Commander's joint Special project.
- Election and Election reports must be submitted in accordance with established deadlines.
- All Post and Bingo (if applicable) inspections must be completed and passed by the District Inspector.

All State Post Awards

- All State Post Citation
- All State Cap (Commander and QM only)
- Acknowledgement in the VFW Leader Magazine
- All State Streamer
- Announcement placed in your local newspaper to announce your achievements
- Department Representative will attend any scheduled Post celebration of the achievement

All State District Criteria

- Achieve membership not less than 101%
- Advance one entry from each Program (VOD, PP, TOY, and Safety to Program Chairman by the prescribed deadlines.
- Conduct School of Instructions within the first quarter of the Election year and report Post attendance to the Department Adjutant.
- Complete all Post and Bingo Inspections (if applicable) within the prescribed timelines, and submit them to Department Inspector.
- Collect a written report from each Post as to their activities prior to each C of A and Convention and turn into the Dept Adj 1 week prior.
- District Commander, Sr Vice Commander, or Jr Vice Commander, Quartermaster and/or Adjutant must attend each District Meeting.
- All Bond applications, trustee reports and IRS filings must be submitted prior to established deadlines.
