- Divisions 4, 5, 6, and 7 must be 102% plus one by 1/31/2024.
- Divisions 1, 2, and 3 must be 102% plus one by 2/29/2024.

- All Honor Posts will receive a pennant/plaque designating it as such.
- Honor Posts will be entered into a drawing by Divisions 8, 9, 10, and 11 for a \$100 VFW Store Gift Card after 12/31/23
- Honor Posts will be entered into a drawing by Divisions 4, 5, 6, and 7 for a \$100 VFW Store Gift Card after 01/31/24

ALL STATE CRITERIA

The all state program exists to recognize exceptional leadership and teamwork, authentic accomplishments in membership growth and VFW core programs.

All State Post Criteria

- Membership greater than 102%
- Voice of Democracy- minimum of one entry advanced to district.
- Patriots Pen- minimum of one entry advanced to district
- Teacher of the Year- minimum of one entry in any category (k-5, 6-8, 9-12) advanced to district.
- JROTC of the year- minimum of one entry advanced to district.
- Police, Fire, Dispatcher, or EMS of the year- minimum of one entry advance to district.
- Business of the Year- one entry advance to District
- Comrade of the Year- minimum of one entry sent to department.
- Commander, adjutant, quartermaster, and minimum of one trustee must attend Department School of Instruction (the Senior Vice may attend in place of the Commander and the Junior Vice may attend in place of the Senior Vice).
- Commander and Quartermaster must attend all district meetings and conventions (the Senior Vice may attend in place of the Commander and the Junior Vice may attend in place of the Senior Vice).
- All canteen fees must be paid by August 31,
- All bond applications (Aug 31), trustee audits and 990 IRS filings must be submitted prior to established deadlines.
- Must complete Post inspections, Bingo inspections (if applicable) and 1st canteen inspections (if applicable) prior to the Fall Council of Administration (C of A); Must complete 2nd canteen inspection prior to the Mid-Winter C of A.
- Must submit Post Election reports within 30 days of election (May). Reports must be complete to include a Post Service Officer.
- Must conduct at least (1) membership drive between July 1 and December 31, 2023. Written report must be submitted to Department Dashboard.

- Must conduct at least (1) membership drive between January 1 and June 1, 2024. Written report must be submitted to Department Dashboard.
- Must purchase allotment Buddy Poppies (3 per member) as of June 30th membership totals.
- Post Commander must submit monthly reports to District Commander.
- Post must sell allotment of Department Raffle tickets (1 tickets per members on roll as of June 30th 2023). As an incentive, If Post sells 1-500 Tickets *over allotted amount* post will get \$2/ticket anything over 501 Tickets will receive \$3/tickets.
- Post to donate \$25 to the Billy Ray Cameron Open (Option –host an event that raises \$25 for the scholarship or provide a donation of \$25 to the Billy Ray/Otis Brown Scholarship).
- Buddy Poppy King, Queen, Prince and or Princess Entry-minimum of one entry in any category to District. (*Post can donate \$300 in lieu of entry*).

- Teacher of the Year- minimum of one entry in either category (k-5, 6-8, 9-12) advanced to Department.
- JROTC of the year- minimum of one entry advanced to Department.
- Police, Fire, Dispatcher, or EMS of the year- minimum of one entry advance to Department.
- Business of the Year- one entry advance to Department
- Commander, Adjutant, Quartermaster, and minimum of one Trustee must attend Department School of Instruction (the Senior Vice may attend in place of the Commander and the Junior Vice may attend in place of the Senior Vice).
- Commander and Quartermaster must attend all district meetings and conventions (the Senior Vice may attend in place of the Commander and the Junior Vice may attend in place of the Senior Vice).
- All bond applications, trustee audits and 990 IRS filings must be submitted prior to established deadlines.

- Must submit District Election reports within 30 days of election. Reports must be complete to include a District Service Officer.
- Must conduct at least (1) membership/buddy poppy drive between July 1 and December 31, 2023. Written report must be submitted to Department Dashboard.
- Must conduct at least (1) membership/buddy poppy drive between January 1 and June 1, 2024. Written report must be submitted to Department Dashboard.
- Each District must sell allotment of 250 Department Raffle Tickets.
- District Commander must submit quarterly reports to Department Adjutant. (10 days prior to the C of A and Department convention).
- Post to donate \$25 to the Billy Ray Cameron Open (Option –host an event that raises \$25 for the scholarship or provide a donation of \$25 to the Billy Ray/Otis Brown Scholarship).
- Buddy Poppy King, Queen, Prince, Princess Entry-minimum of one entry in any category to Department chairperson.
- Must conduct all required Post inspections prior to Fall C of A, a second canteen inspection prior to Mid-Winter C of A.
- District Commander, QM, and (1) trustee must attend one of the four school of instructions (Senior Vice may attend in place of commander and Junior vice in place of the Senior Vice).
